## **OUR PROJECTS**









Magdalen Farm <a href="https://magdalenfarm.org.uk/">https://magdalenfarm.org.uk/</a> for several years we have been funding residential breaks for groups of children at Magdalen Farm, an idyllic 132 acre organic working farm in Dorset.. Their trips were action packed with opportunities to make friends with the farm animals, pick food in the kitchen garden, build shelters and a campfire, orienteer, play in the mud and river and to roam through the fields. For many it is their first time away. The feedback from all our charities is always very encouraging. They talk about how valuable the experience has been for building confidence, learning new skills, adapting to a different environment, learning to work together and above all having fun. We are very proud of this ongoing partnership and grateful to everyone who make these visits so special.

It was lovely to welcome so many wonderful young people from Ebony. There were some new faces and old friends. Greatwood <a href="https://www.greatwoodcharity.org/">https://www.greatwoodcharity.org/</a> At the end of May two of our trustees went to visit our new Young Carers project run by Greatwood in conjunction with Youth Action Wiltshire. The programme aims to provide a day's respite break for Young Carers in Wiltshire 4 times a year to build self-esteem and improve mental health through "animal assisted intervention". The day involved mucking out, grooming the horses, riding on the jockey horse and feeding and playing with a number of smaller animals. It also provided a space for the young people to get to know each other and share their experiences. The feedback from the young people was very positive - "I have had an amazing day at Greatwood, "I loved the animals and time to chill", "Today has been the best day" and "I really want to go again if we can, can we?". It was wonderful to see first-hand the impact of the work and we hope to continue to support this programme moving forward.
